Champagne

- 29. Champagne Veuve Clicquot Brut** £49.95
Yellow Label
Founded in 1772 and named after the widow of the founder - Madame Clicquot Ponsardin. A blend of 50 Crus with over 50% of the blend of Pinot Noir, giving the wine "forcefulness with finesse"
- 30. Champagne Joseph Perrier Cuvee** £39.95
Royale Brut NV
A classic blend of Pinot and Chardonnay, this is a very accessible fruity style of Champagne

Sparkling Wines

- 31. Quartet Louis Roederer Estate,** £29.95
Anderson Valley (USA)
From 4 distinct vineyards, this is a 70:30 blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir producing a crisp, elegant Roederer style with great finesse
- 32. Cava Brut Reserva Mas Macia** £22.95
(Spain)
A stylish and thoroughly drinkable modern Cava
- 33. Marquis de la Cour Rose (France)** £19.95
A rose pink with fine bubbles and a red fruit aroma of raspberries and redcurrants. Supple fruity finish
